Purposes

The Friends of the Yarra Valley Park is a group whose focus is the protection, restoration and enhancement of the natural environment of the Yarra Valley. The Friends of the Yarra Valley Park will:-

- (1) Include as many groups and individuals of all ages as possible in this endeavour so that a real sense of community ownership and public awareness and involvement is created.
- (2) Bring together those who care for the Yarra Valley and its natural resources, prehistory and history.
- (3) Respect the views of Wurundjeri and consult them on issues of mutual concern and interests.
- (4) Encourage and initiate programs which will revegetate the park with indigenous plants. This will assist in protecting and enhancing the quality of air, water, soil and biodiversity of the Yarra Valley Park.
- (5) Protect, enhance and recreate habitat for indigenous fauna, including the river, billabongs and wetlands and assist in their management.
- (6) Gather information on the park and the environs.
- (7) Communicate and discuss issues on the environment with other individuals and groups.
- (8) Provide input into planning and other issues which may affect the park.
- (9) Develop the Friends by arranging outings and activities for the education and enjoyment of members and their families.
- (10) Promote environmental education of the friends and community at large. Through this joint endeavour, the Friends will work to make the Yarra Valley Park one of the great urban conservation parks.
